

## Sussex Doctoral Open Research Prize

As part of its Research England funded initiative to promote Open Research activity at Sussex University is pleased to launch its first Doctoral Open Research Prize.

Sussex encourages doctoral students to explore and engage with Open Research practices in their work and study, to maximise the possibility of public and academic engagement and impact. The aim of this prize is to reward and encourage PhD research that has been or will be more “open” than is typical in your discipline.

The prize will either:

- a) Recognise exceptional examples of Open Research that you have already delivered in your ongoing PhD or
- b) Enable you to spend time delivering specific exceptional Open Research with an innovative plan

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- If you are proposing new activity, we will ask you to provide a brief report on what you have achieved by the end of September 2022.

## Funding

We expect to make around 15 awards.

Students already in receipt of a scholarship paid by Sussex, will receive a scholarship extension of 1 month's stipend (£1,300) and fees.
